DATE:

The wrestling competition at the 2002 North American Indigenous Games is tentatively scheduled for August 1 - August 3, 2002.

COMPETITION VENUE:

The wrestling competition at the 2002 North American Indigenous Games will be held at the Daniel MacIntyre Collegiate.

EVENT:

The NAIG wrestling competition consist of both male and female individual competition for the midget, juvenile, junior and senior age classification.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

In the double elimination bracket draw format a win advances the wrestler to the next round and closer to the final. A first loss relegates the athlete to the repechage (consolation) rounds for (third place) and a second loss eliminates the athlete from the competition. The size of the bracket is a multiple of 2: 2,4,8,16,32, 64 and so on.

OFFICIALS:

All officials will be designated by the Host Society and approved by the Manitoba Freestyle Wrestling Association.

PARTICIPANTS:

Number of Competitors:

Each Province, Territory and State is allowed to enter one (1) male and one (1) female athlete per weight division for each age group.

Number of Coaches:

Each Province, Territory and State may accredit two (2) coaches and one (1) manager per bantam; midget, juvenile, junior and senior age classification. The staff composition must have a minimum of one (1) female staff.

GENERAL RULES:

The 2002 or most recent version of the Canadian Amateur Wrestling Association (CAWA) will apply to the NAIG wrestling competition.

COMPETITION RULES:

The Midget age group category is referred to as the Cadet age category according to the CAWA rules and regulations.

The Junior and Senior age group categories shall be combined into one wrestling category as defined as the senior age group in the CAWA rules and regulations.

The pre-competition weight-in will take place for one half hour for each age category on the evening prior to the first day of competition, July 31. The NAIG competition will have only one (1) weigh-in session as above.

FIELD OF PLAY REQUIREMENTS\EQUIPMENT:

The wrestler must supply her/his own equipment and must comply with the Canadian Amateur Wrestling Association (CAWA). Athletes must have a red or blue singlet, socks and wrestling shoes free of buckles and metal ridges, tape, and a handkerchief to be tucked inside the singlet for blood. Headgear is optional.
